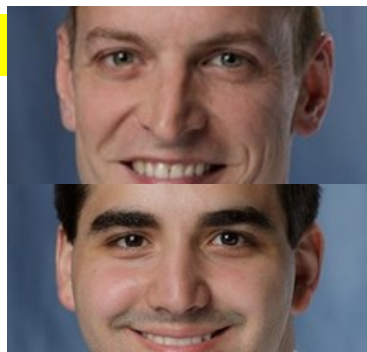

This makes two wins this year already for Shands Red!

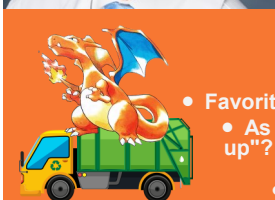

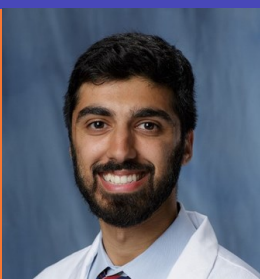
Nicholas Vernace, PGY-1

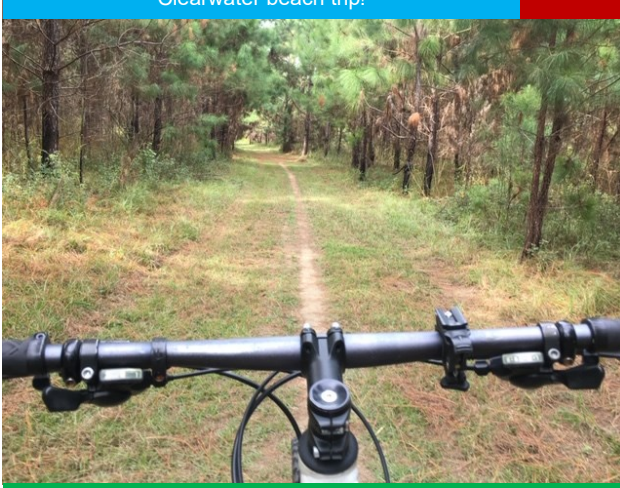
